




## Excellence for Everyone: A Whole School Approach

Drawing on research-based content and experiences, professionals concentrate on a target cohort to gain clear insights into the issues and needs of disadvantaged pupils. Practice that is proved to be effective for these students can then be rolled out more widely across the school. Successful strategies are cascaded by each member of the school team, resulting in deep, consistent, school-wide impact. Working collaboratively, schools think big, start small and scale quickly to have a far-reaching impact to make a lasting difference.
